Catechetical Sermon Series I – Baptism and the Ten Commandments

- **Hymns**: The hymns selected come from *Lutheran Service Book LSB* (CPH, 2006). At times more than three hymns are offered as options. Readers preaching on the Catechism may find other hymns more appropriate for their congregational circumstance.
- **Catechetical readings**: The page numbers for the catechetical readings are also taken from *LSB*. If one is using a hymnal that does not contain Luther's *Small Catechism*, the catechetical readings can be printed in a bulletin insert.
- **Multiple options**: At times I have included multiple scripture readings or more than 3 hymn suggestions, reflecting some of the variations I made over the years.
